

Mary and Joseph

I know it's still November, but we are going to spend the next 4 weeks on Christmas! This week we are looking at Mary and Joseph. You might feel like you know this story really well already, but there is always something new we can learn and think about. It might be that you are now ready to read the whole story of the Nativity in the 'proper' Bible rather than a children's Bible. It is found in Matthew 1-2 and Luke 1-2.

Craft activity 1

Colour the picture of Mary and Joseph. Around the outside, write any qualities you think Mary and Joseph have eg humble, willing, trusting, loyal, patient, faithful. Some of these are similar to the Fruit of the Spirit that we have just finished learning about! Pray about these and ask God to help you grow in these qualities.

Craft activity 2

Print and cut out the nativity characters. You could back them on card or stick them on lollipop sticks to make puppets. Use these to retell the story.

Craft activity 3

There is a cute bauble activity to print, cut out and make.

If you don't have a printer, you could make your own designs of any of the above.

There are also wordsearches and puzzles to keep you busy.
